

## WELCOME TO OUR VISITORS

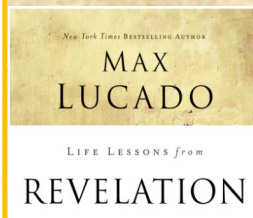
